

C2BII Installation - Version 1.0.4

Revision March 20 2009

You must have installed at least Windows Vista, or Windows XP SP2 or later. Both 32 and 64 bit versions are ok. Do not attempt to install on a system with Windows XP SP1 or previous. The application will be installed, but the “Microsoft SQL Server 2005 Express Edition Service Pack 2” will have problems, and thus the application eventually will not start.

The following instructions are applicable for a first time installation. For upgrading an existing installation, first you must uninstall the existing version. Uninstalling instructions can be found at the bottom of this.

Step 1

Download and install:

a) Microsoft .NET Framework version 2.0

32bit Version

b) Microsoft Windows Installer 3.1

Both of the above are required by “Microsoft SQL Server 2005 Express Edition Service Pack 2”.

Step 2

Download and **save (do not install yet)** to a folder in your hard disk drive:

Microsoft SQL Server 2005 Express Edition Service Pack 2.

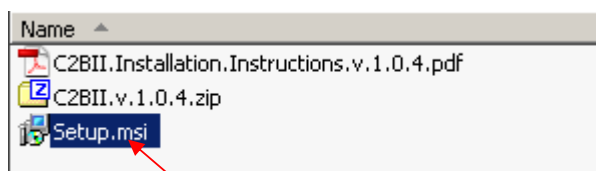

Step 3

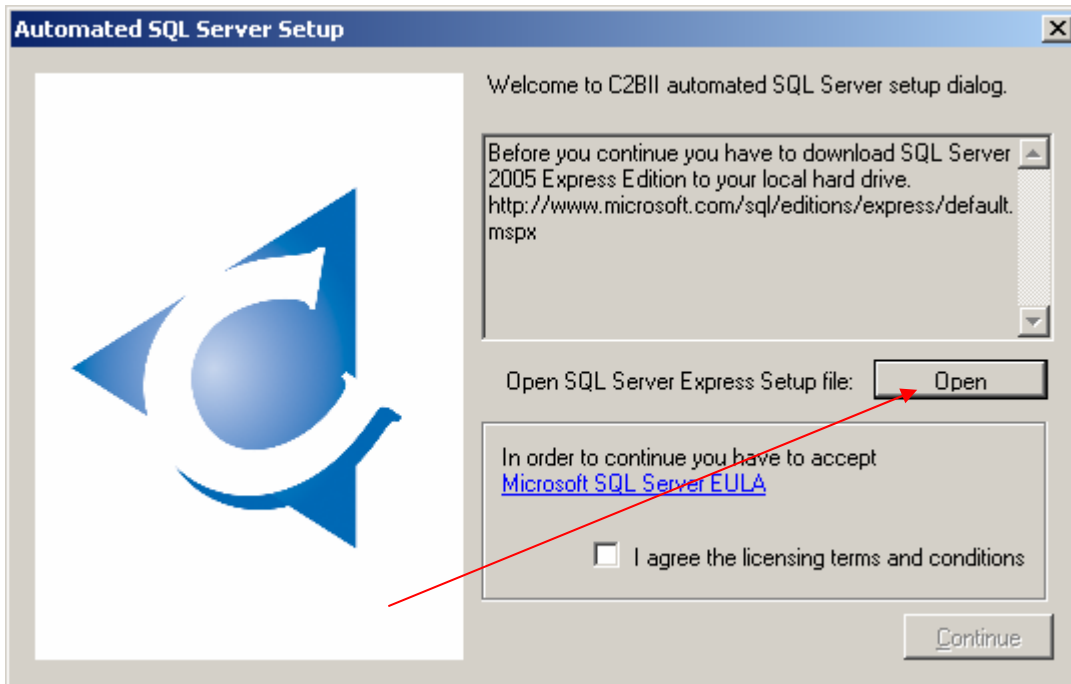
Extract the included files from the downloaded archive to your hard disk.

Install C2BII by running the file “Setup.msi”

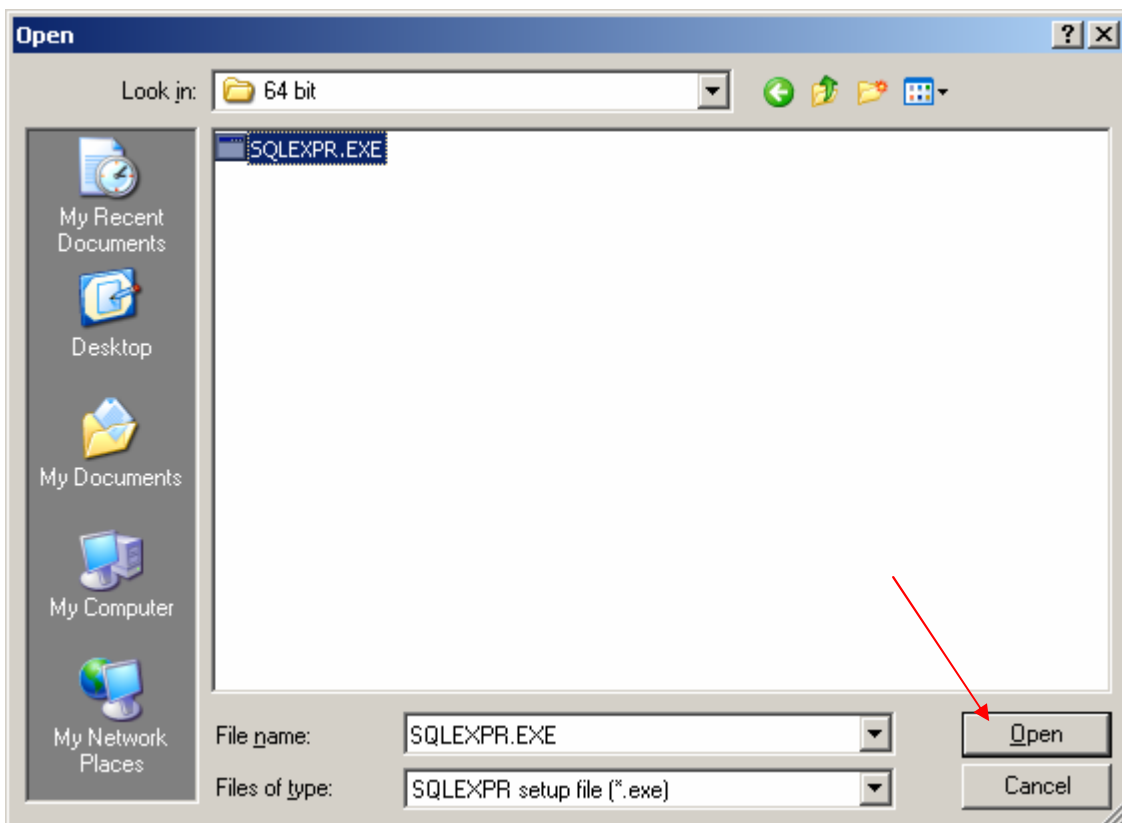


Step 4

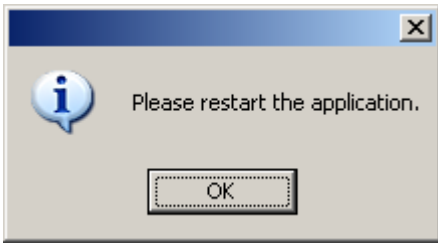
After you have finished the installation, and you try to run for the first time the installed program, it will try to locate “MS SQL Server 2005 Express Edition Service Pack 2”. This process might take a few seconds, so please be patient. Since it is not installed yet, it will give you the following message:



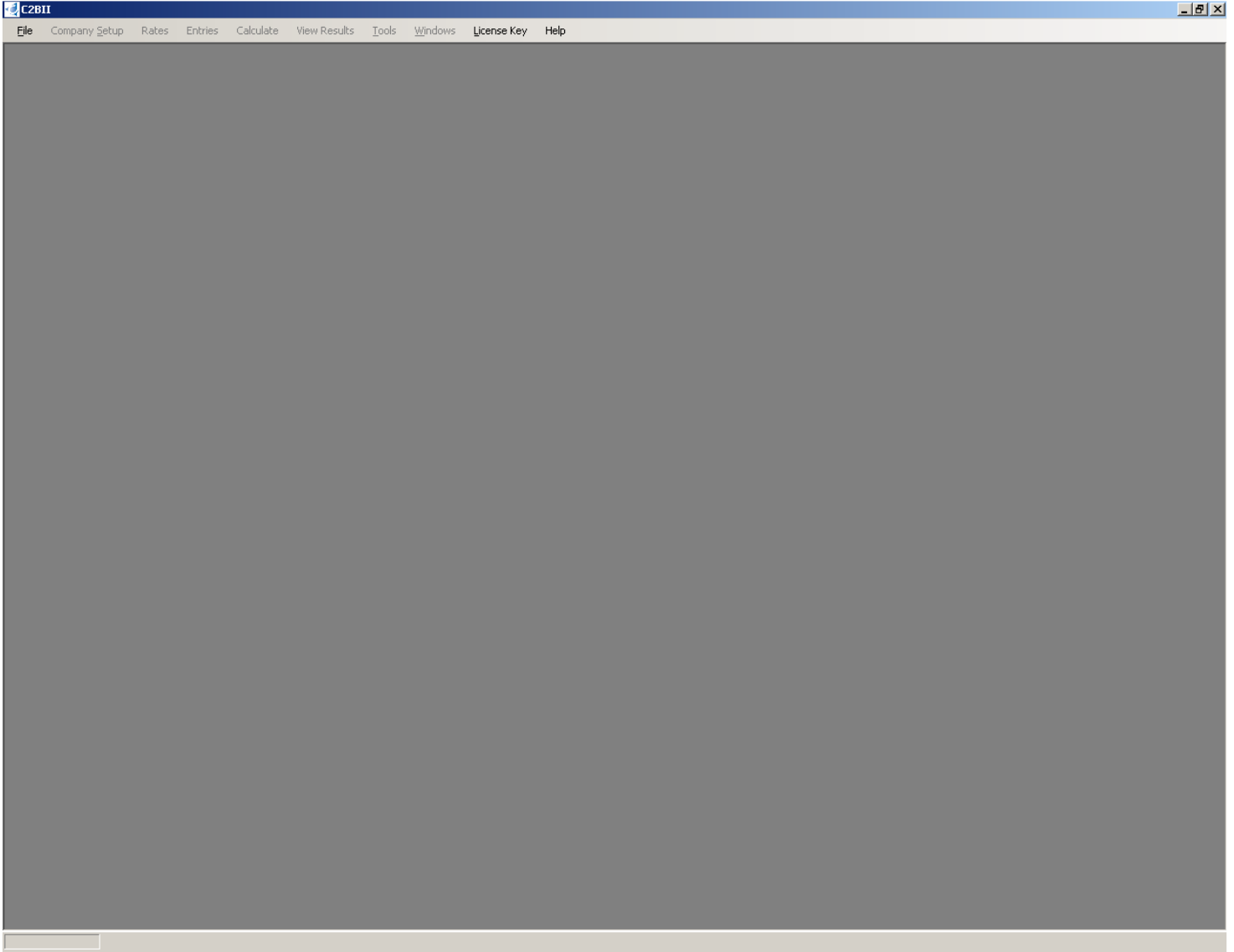
After clicking on open, you must point to the saved “MS SQL Server 2005 Express Edition Service Pack 2” installation file, and open it. C2BII will install it and create an instance to which only it will have access.



After the installation of “SQL Server 2005 Express Edition Service Pack 2” completes, the program will ask you to restart the application.

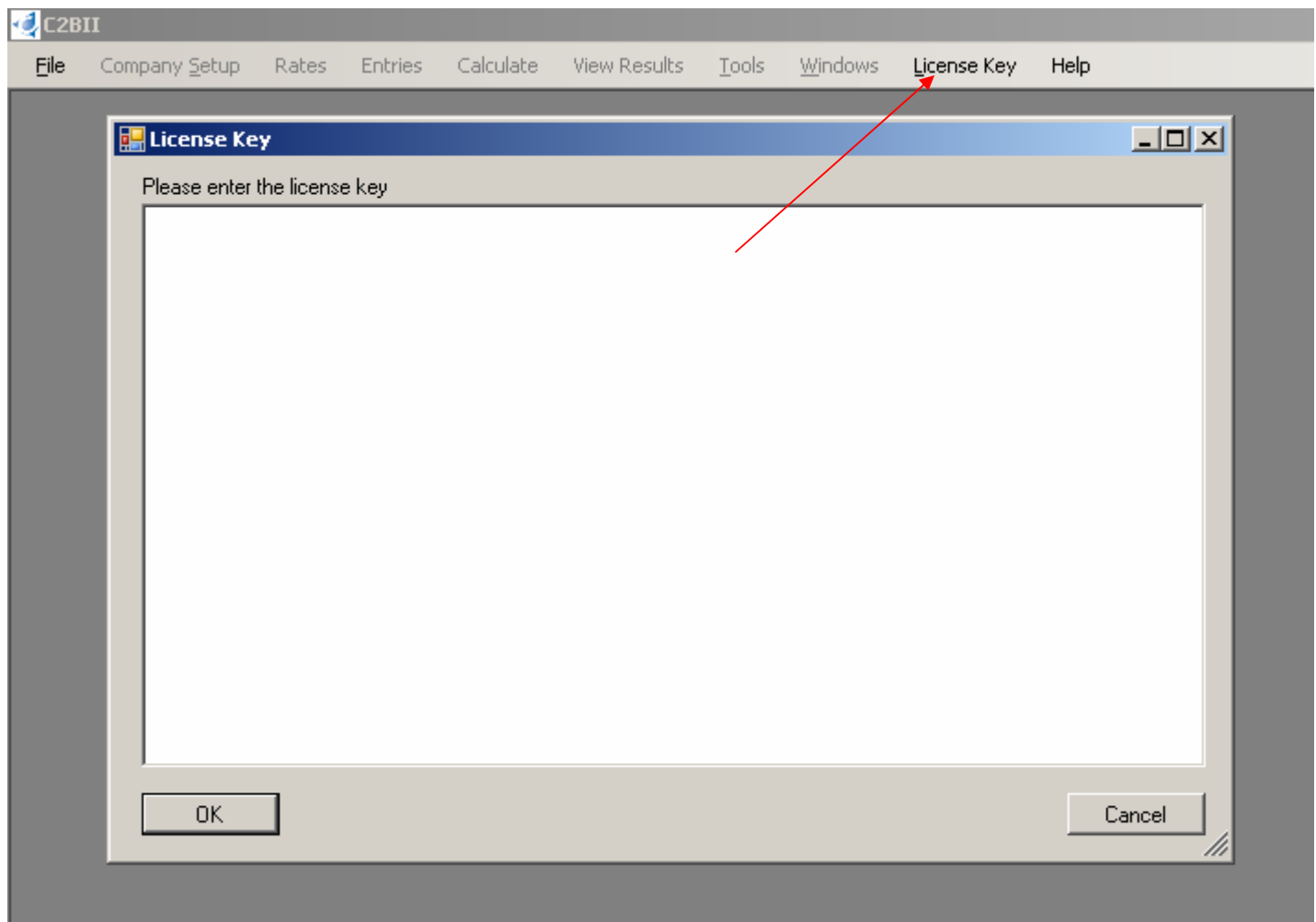


Then you open the program and you see the starting screen.



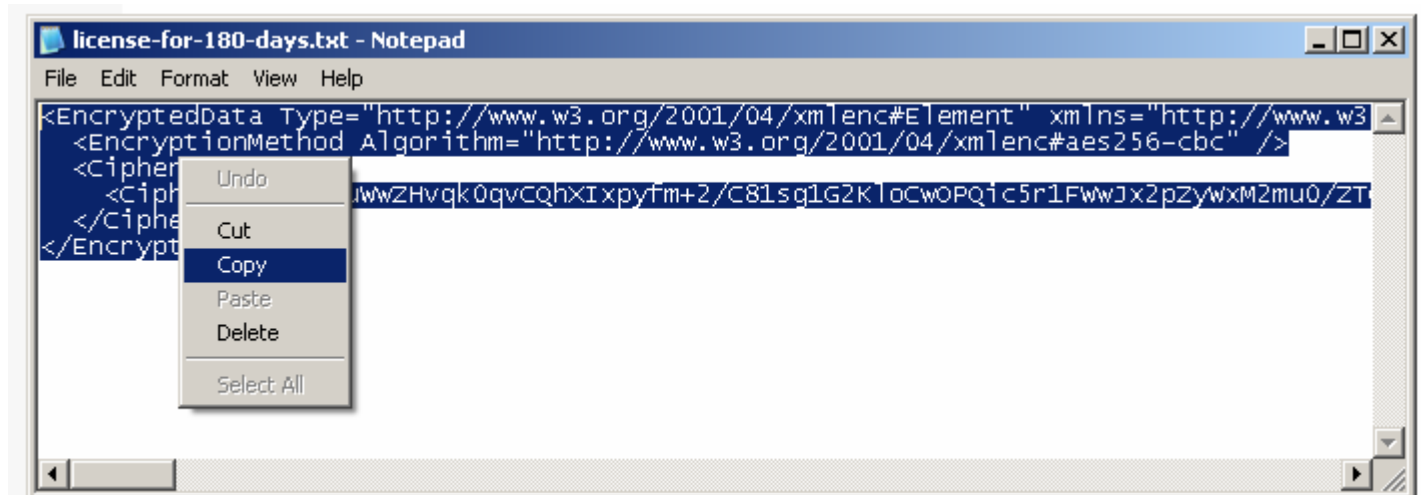
Step 5 – Entering of License Key

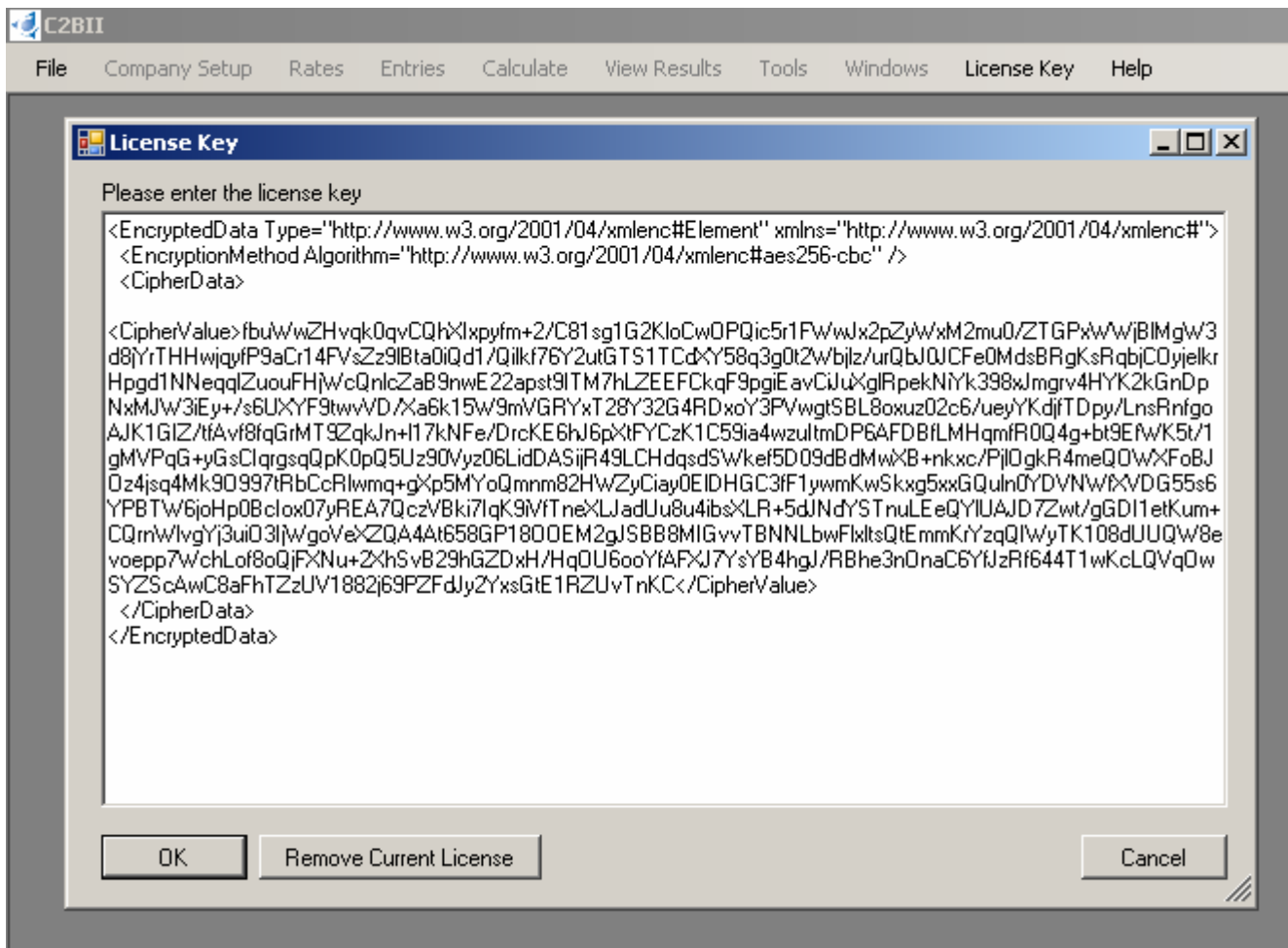
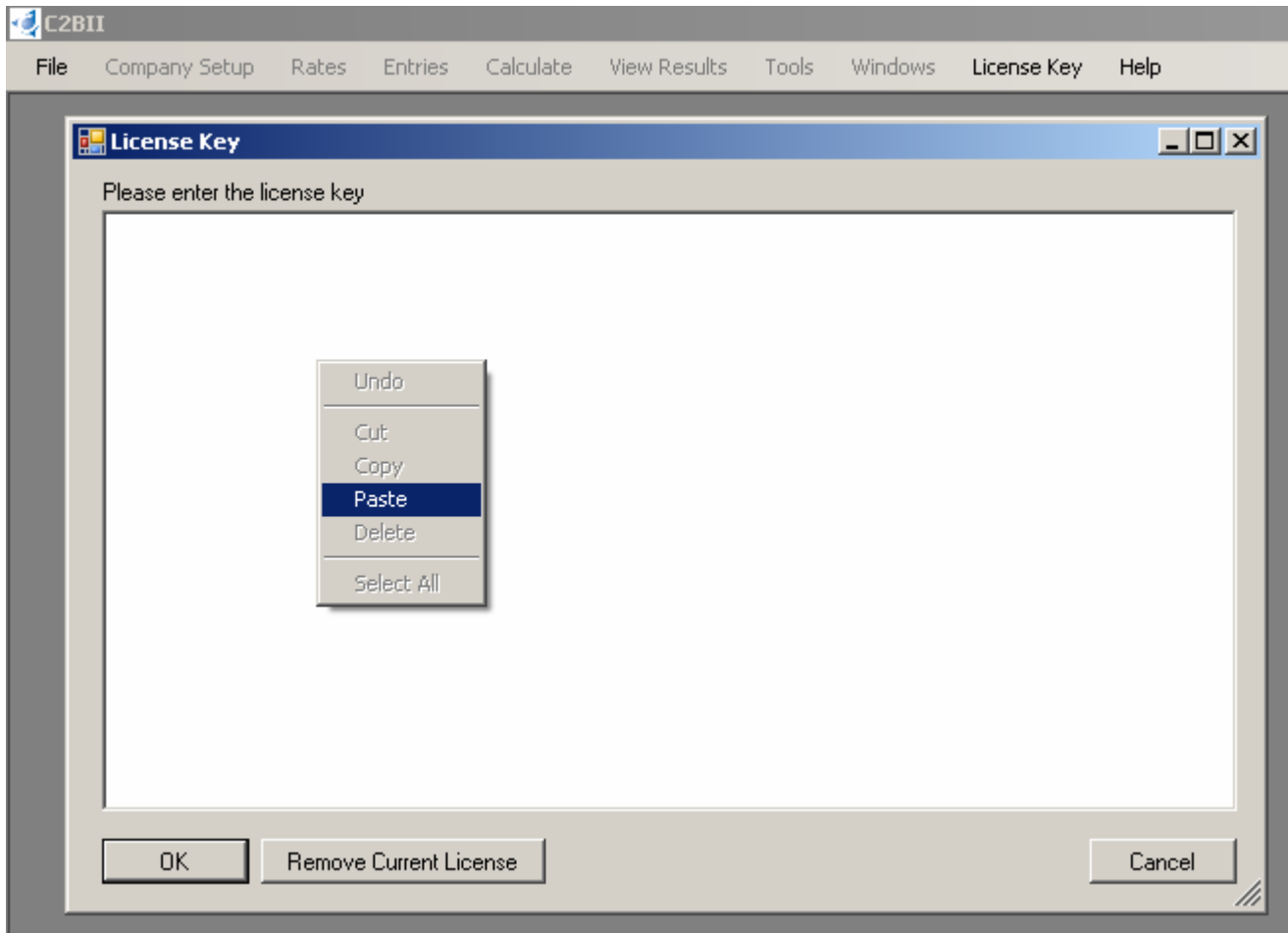
After pressing “License Key” you see the following window.



Inside it you must paste the contents of the TXT file that you received when you purchased the License Key.

If you do not enter a valid License Key, the program will start in evaluation mode. It is going to have all menus and options available to the user, but the number of entries in some menus is restricted (in some up to 10 entries and in some up to 25 entries). That is a number of entries that is sufficient in order to understand and evaluate the program’s functionality, but it is not sufficient for performing professional work.

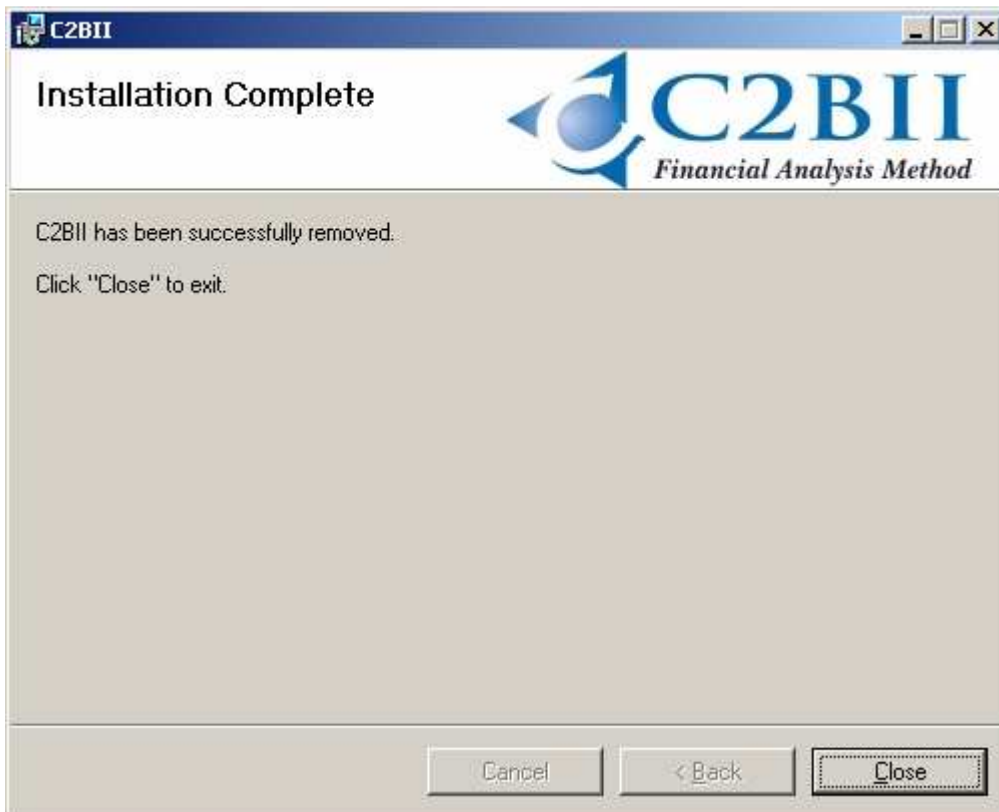
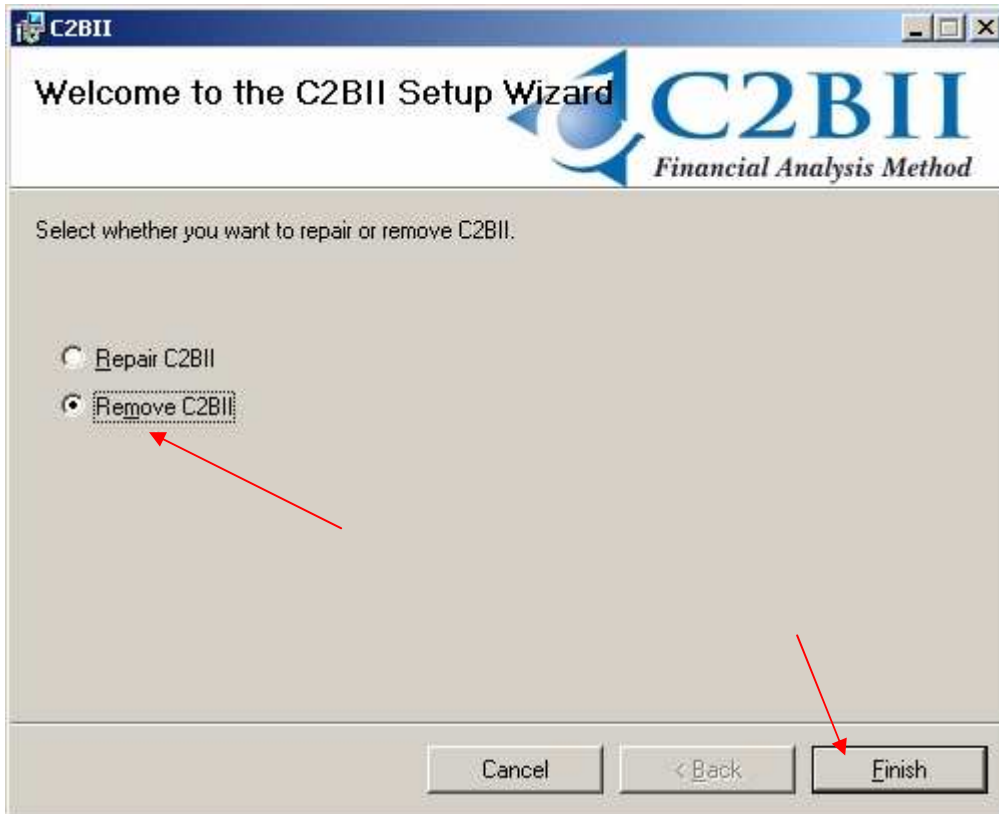

Uninstalling before upgrading to a newer version

In order to uninstall C2BII, you must run the exact same file that you used for the installation. The program will find that C2BII is already installed, and will ask you what action you wish to take. You choose “Remove C2BII”, and then you press “Finish”.



The above procedure has uninstalled only C2BII. It has not removed “Microsoft SQL Server 2005 Express Edition Service Pack 2”. From that point, you are able to install a newer version of C2BII. The existing License key has not been erased.
